Wrist Bands

Everyone who enters the gate MUST have a wrist band, Director's badge or be wearing a performer's uniform. We are providing ONE (1) wrist band for every TEN (10) performers listed on your registration form for chaperones. Wrist bands for directors and INSTRUCTIONAL STAFF will be given according to the staff you have listed. (these names need to be submitted to us in advance with your announcer's form. Please only list staff who will be attending the competition. Please note that your truck drivers will be given a wrist band as well (this is not part of your 1 per 10 chaperone allotment.)

Check-In Table / Arrival

The side entrance of the school on **Haverhill Road** will be clearly marked for entrance of your buses and your equipment trucks at the northwest end of the campus. Please follow the signs to the Check-in Table at the bus drop off point. Wristbands will be distributed to your allotted chaperones and staff you entered on your registration form at that time. Each band will be assigned a host for the day and will be escorted to all areas for warm-up and performance. We are here to assist you!

Equipment Trucks / Trailers

Equipment trucks will be parked and unloaded on the west side of the campus. A parking guide will be there to help with directions of where to park. *All equipment trucks MUST enter from the Haverhill Road entrance.* The pit and all instruments will be unloaded for students to pick up and then move to warm-up. *Please allow enough time to unload, pick up equipment, and travel to warm-up spot. If your program has a Semi Truck or Large Equipment Truck, please let us know so we can park you in an appropriate parking spot.

Tickets will be \$15.00 per person at the gate. Children 5 and younger will be admitted free.

Band Grams are available for \$3.00 each. The announcer will read the purchased Band Grams just prior to your band entering the field.

Food and Drinks

The concession stand will be open all day. A copy of our menu is available in this packet for your review.

NOTE: No outside cooking or meal preparation is permitted on school grounds.

Logistics

- You will have 15 minutes from the moment you leave the starting gate to the moment you complete your show (with a salute or last note of the closer).
- You MUST exit with a tap, so as to allow the next band to enter on time.
- You may bring up to 5 students for the Drum Major retreat.
- Your Drum Majors will be brought over to the far side line immediately following the last band's performance. They will move forward with our two Drum Majors' as they move to the Press Box side of the field on their assigned yard line.

Stadium Seating

Stadium seating is limited. Please do not take equipment to the stands, so we can use all the seating space for student seating.

Bad Weather

In the event of bad weather, the bands will be placed in a holding area under shelter, warm-up areas will be assigned, and the performance will take place in the gymnasium.
